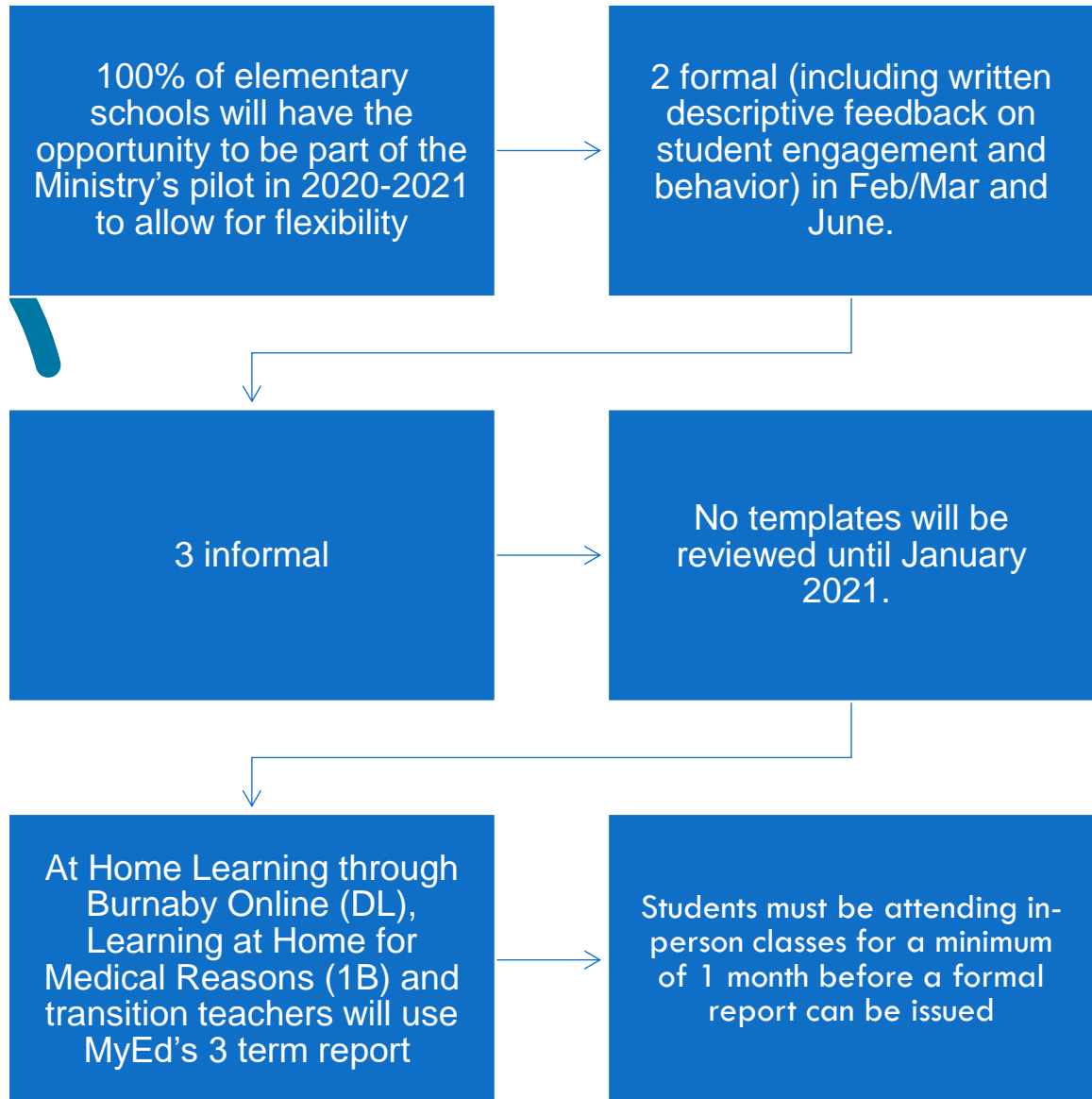

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- Schools will oversee in-person administration of FSA exams (online and booklet)
 - Invite students in the transition option to attend the in-person testing sessions
 - Schools are asked to label, distribute and collect, exam booklets for Gr. 4 and 7 for Learning at home through Burnaby Online (DL), Learning at Home for Medical Reasons (1B) and transition teachers
 - Ces, Teresa, Denis and I will coordinate the administration of the online portion of the FSA exams with the students in their programs

- Parent/teacher conference (documentation necessary)
- 3-way conference (documentation necessary)
- Interim report – curricular competencies and descriptive feedback that focusses on literacy, numeracy and areas that require support (optional district template will be provided)

*areas of concern should be addressed in the fall



Indigenizing assessment and reporting
